



Clinical Canvas 2026 **Poster Competition**

1. Venue – Uttoran, North Bengal Medical College
2. Date - 26 July 2026
3. Eligibility and Team Composition:
 - The competition is open to all final year MBBS students, interns, house staff and Post Graduate Trainees (PGTs) of North Bengal Medical College.
 - Participants may compete individually or in teams of a maximum of six members.
 - Each participant may contribute to only one poster.
 - Change of team members after registration shall not be permitted.
 - Prior Registration is free but mandatory (No spot registration)
4. The poster must be based on a clinically relevant medical topic, including but not limited to:
 - Clinical case presentation
 - Diagnostic approach
 - Public health relevance
 - Innovative management strategy
 - Medical education
 - Research or evidence-based medicine
5. The content must be original and not previously awarded in any competition.
6. Posters should maintain scientific accuracy, ethical standards, and patient confidentiality at all times. Any identifying patient information or photographs must not be displayed without proper consent.
7. The poster should be prepared in **3 ft × 4 ft. portrait orientation**.
8. Both printed and hand-crafted posters will be accepted. Digital design is encouraged.
9. Each poster must clearly mention:
 - Title of the poster

- Name(s) of participant(s)
- Academic designation (Final Year/Intern/House Staff/PGT)

10. Participants must report at the venue at least 30 minutes before the scheduled judging time. A brief oral presentation of 3–5 minutes must be required before the judges.

12. Evaluation will be based on:

- Scientific content
- Clinical relevance
- Originality and innovation
- Visual presentation
- Clarity and communication

13. Use of plagiarized material will lead to immediate disqualification.

14. Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools may be used only as supportive aids for language refinement, formatting, grammar correction, illustration assistance, or design enhancement. Any use of AI-generated text, images, graphics, or design elements must be clearly disclosed at the bottom corner of the poster under the heading: "AI Assistance Declaration."

15. Participants remain fully responsible for the scientific accuracy, originality, ethical integrity, and authenticity of all submitted content, irrespective of AI assistance. The organizing committee reserves the right to seek clarification regarding the extent and nature of AI usage in poster preparation.

16. Fully AI-generated posters without substantial participant contribution are discouraged and may be disqualified at the discretion of the judges.

17. Fabricated references, manipulated clinical data, or AI-generated misleading medical information will result in immediate disqualification.

19. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.

20. Organizers reserve the right to modify the schedule or rules if necessary.

- **First Prize:** INR 6,000
- **Second Prize:** INR 4,000
- **Third Prize:** INR 2,000
